Fingal County Council keeps the pressure on non-compliers with the Packaging Regulations

Fingal County Council this week expressed their satisfaction at the successful prosecution, under the Waste Management Acts, of BR Marketing Ltd. an importer/distributor of food products to the wholesale, retail and catering grocery trade, operating from premises in Rosemount Business Park, Ballycoolin. The district court case was heard in early November.

Fingal County Council took the prosecution against BR Marketing for failure to comply with the Waste Management (Packaging) Regulations. Although BR Marketing had subsequently become fully compliant with the Regulations, the judge fined the company €3,000 and awarded the Council costs of €1,564.89. The judge pointed out that the Council officials were “not there for the fun of it” when passing sentence.

Alan Sherry, Senior Staff Officer, Environment Department, Fingal County Council expressed his satisfaction with the outcome of the case and emphasised that there would be three more cases in court before the end of the year.
